Survey on inclusiveness

- **OBJECTIVE:** measure performance of LPCs
 - Identify good performers in the bioeconomy ERA-NETs
 - Use as a positive example when targeting those countries that continue to perform low.
- **HOW:** by looking at
 - participation of LPCs in bioeconomy ERA-NETs
 - role of LPCs when participation is secured (type of activity they perform, participation in joint transnational calls and their success rate, etc.).
- **PRACTICAL** use of results:
 - basis for the PLATFORM Inclusiveness Master Class in spring 2016

A look into the survey

- Response from 22 different ERA-NETs
- Best performers based on survey:
 - Participation: PT, SI, TUR, PL, LT, LA, EE
 - Active participation: PT, SI, PL, EE
 - JTC participation: LA, PT, SL, PL
 - Funding: PL, PT, SI
- Problems encountered by LPCs
 - Inability to secure funds
 - Few project proposals with research partners from LPCs
 - Inability to use funds due to lower ranking of projects with partners from LPCs in ranking list
 - Lack of flexibility of national rules
 - contracting problems
